

# ArcGIS Pro

## Download and Install

Go to <https://maps.cise.jmu.edu>, click the link for [ArcGIS & Esri Licensing](#), Agree to the Esri Terms of Service, log in using your JMU eID and password, and finally [Download and Install ArcGIS Pro 1.4](#).

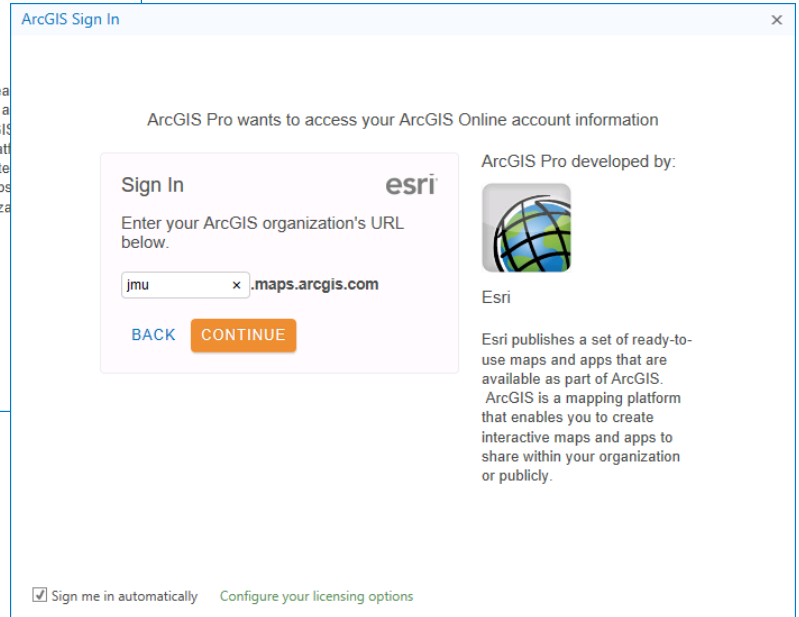

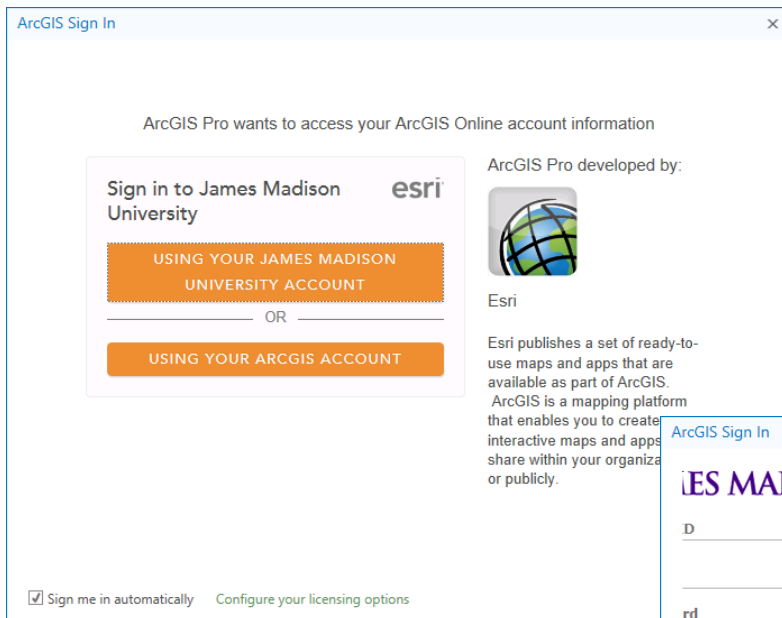
# Logging into ArcGIS Pro



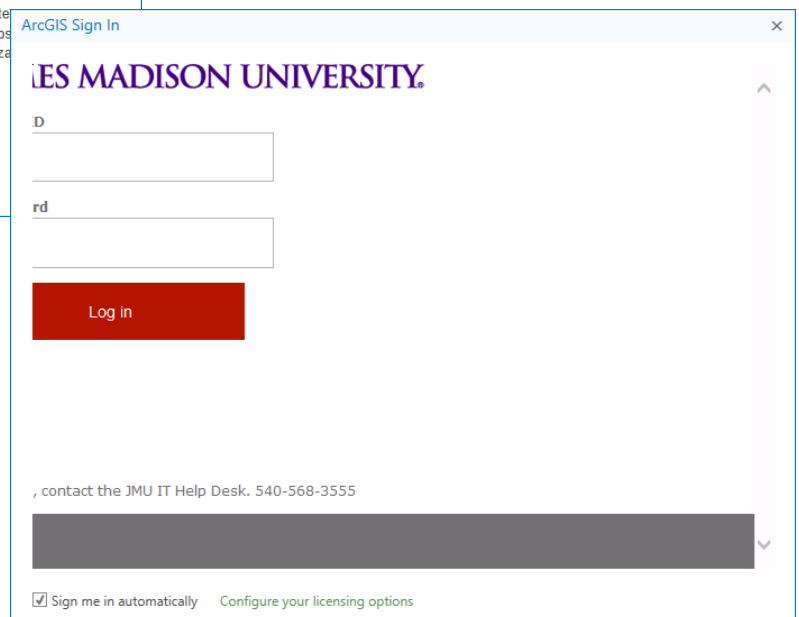
To sign in, click the option at the initial loading screen, at the project creation screen, or at the top-right corner of the main window. In the Sign In windows, click the button to sign in with “Enterprise Account”.



Specify our organization’s URL as “jmu” and continue.



Click the button to sign in “Using your James Madison University Account”.



Finally, enter your JMU eID and password.

The page may appear partly hidden. Simply click into each field and type your eID, password, then click the “Log in” button – it should work anyway.

## Logging Out of ArcGIS Pro

You should now be logged into ArcGIS Pro. The software can be allowed to remember your login each time. If you wish to log out, simply click the “Sign out” link at the top-right of the application window.
