COMPUTER LAB USE

- Computers are the property of JMU and the state - please respect.
- Please do not store personal data on lab computers.
 - Keep personal data on USB storage devices.
- Your JMU eID is key to accessing labs, data and technical resources.
 - Log into lab computers and trusted JMU websites with your eID and password.
 - Never share your password.
 - You will never be asked to email or otherwise provide your password to another person. Ever.

JMU FILE SERVICES

- The University provides centralized file storage for faculty, staff and departments.
 - This is known as the "N" drive on most computers.
- Students typically have read-only access to the "Lab" folder.
 - Department lab data is under CS, ISAT, or GS.
 - We tried provisioning space for student lab use, but it ultimately proved inadequate - please use your own USB storage device in the labs.
- Other folders are private to employees or departments and cannot be viewed.

GEOGRAPHY FILE SERVICES

- Geography maintains an independent, central storage server for department data.
 - This is know as "Geo" or the "R" drive in the labs.
- Students typically have read-only access to much of this space.
 - Large datasets are kept within the "EarthInfo", "Esri", "GPS", and "LiDAR" folders.
 - The "Classes" folder contains large class data specific the course being taught or faculty presenting it.
 - The "Projects" folder are for independent faculty projects - students on such projects may have access.
