


Transferring data using ArcGIS Online Assistant

ArcGIS Online Assistant

The ArcGIS Online Assistant allows users to transfer data themselves from one ArcGIS Online site to another. This will allow someone leaving the university to take content with them. This must be done before their Enterprise login (JMU eID) expires.

To use the Assistant, go to <https://ago-assistant.esri.com> and log in using your Enterprise account.



Log into the system using the JMU Enterprise Account from which you wish to transfer the data:

Copy Content

Once logged into the Assistant, you will see groups and data associated with your account on the left. This is the data you can transfer out of the current AGOL organization.

To initiate the transfer, choose “Copy Content” from the “I want to...” menu.

Content can be copied within the same account, or you can choose another account. You can also copy to a Portal should you choose.



