He worked with his son Frederick W. Newman. Their office was in the Blue Circle Club's building. Fred Newman eventually moved to Washington, DC where he opened an insurance office at Florida and 7th St., NW. Each year the Blue Circle Club and presumably the Newman's hosted a holiday party for the children of the neighborhood.
